all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the City of Greenville on the northeast side  
of Central Avenue, known as the southeast corner of the Marshall Estate, recorded in the Plat Book No. 29 on May 1932, and having the following courses and distances:
