Succesors and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid,

in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville; on the West side of Echols Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 21, Block 2, Page 21 of the City Block Book and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Echols Street, corner of lot now or formerly owned by J. H. Smith, and running thence with the Western side of Echols Street, S. 57-30 W. 46 feet, 8 1/2 inches to an iron pin, corner of lot formerly owned by John J. and A. K. Harrison; thence with the line of said lot, N. 35-15 W. 153 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot now or formerly owned by Mr. B.
