Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of North Main Street and Arlington Avenue, and running thence along Arlington Avenue 214 feet to iron pin on alley, thence S. 34° 22' N. 30 feet to iron pin; thence S. 58° 36' E. 300.7 feet to iron pin on North Main Street; thence along North Main Street N. 31° 10' E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
