Whereas, I, J. H. Strickland, do hereby declare,  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents,  
well and truly indebted to L. A. Ford,

in the full and just sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars  
(\$250.00) Dollars, to be paid in six months of  
Thirty-five dollars per cash six months, first  
payment due March 28th, 1935; additional payments  
due each six months thereafter until paid in full.

with interest thereon from 1935 at the rate of per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-

annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration to the further sum of Three Dollars, to be paid on or before March 28th, 1935,  
the said J. H. Strickland,  
in hand well and truly paid by the said L. A. Ford,

at and before signing of these Presents, the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

L. A. Ford, his heirs and assigns,  
all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate,  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina,  
in Gant Township, on the White Horse Road, and  
having the following metes and bounds, according  
to survey made by S. J. Riddle, Surveyor, July 11,  
1935.

Beginning at a point in center of White Horse  
Road, corner of Taylor's property, and running  
thence north 34-20 west 413.5 feet to an iron pin;  
thence north 55-30 west 103.6 feet to an iron pin;  
thence south 37-50 west 347 feet to a point in the  
center of the White Horse Road; thence along said  
road south 27-20 east 140 feet to the beginning  
corner.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in Gant Township,  
County and State aforesaid on the northeast side  
of White Horse Road and more fully described as  
follows.

Beginning at a point in the White Horse  
Road at corner of S. J. and Blanche M. McClellan's  
land and running thence along their line N. 37-55 E.  
347 feet to iron pin; thence S. 56-30 E. 312.7 feet to  
point in said road; thence along the road S.  
24-10 E. 112.6 feet to the beginning corner.
