interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note on this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 percent of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Mrs. H. M. Gaffney:

all that certain piece, several, or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, near the City of Greenville and on the East side of the New Bonncombe Road, and having the following corners and boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin on the East side of the New Bonncombe Road at the northwest corner of the lot aforesaid conveyed by S. A. Neal to Jason C. Turney three rods to the line of the Jason lot 350 feet, more or less to pin on West side of Cherry Lane Drive, thence along the West side of Cherry Lane Drive in a northerly direction 200 feet, more or less to a pin corner of land now or formerly owned by Murphy, thence with the last mentioned line a southerly direction 200 feet, more or less to pin on the East side of the New Bonncombe Road, thence along the East side of the New Bonncombe Road and in a southerly direction 200 feet, more or less to the beginning corner. Being a portion of the same tract of land conveyed to S. A. Neal by Mary F. Goldsmith, and being the same lot conveyed to me by S. A. Neal May 14th, 1935 and deed recorded in R. M. L.
