## PURCHASE MONEY MORTGAGE

hereinafter called  
first parties whether one or more, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, The said first parties are indebted to ~~The Federal Land Bank of Columbia~~, herein after called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of One Thousand and 987/100

(\$ 1000.98) Dollars,

payable to the order of second party, said principal sum being payable in ~~14~~ twelve (14) equal annual  
installments of ~~sixty-seven and 7/100 (\$67.70)~~ dollars each  
and a final installment of ~~thirty-five and 7/100 (\$35.70)~~ dollars

(Dollars)

together with interest on the whole amount of said principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of ~~Five and 5/100~~ per centum per annum  
from January 1, 1941, payable annually on the same date that the annual payment on the principal is to be made,

the first installment on the principal being payable on the ~~first day of January~~, 1942, and one of the  
successive installments being payable on the same date of each succeeding year thereafter until the entire principal sum, together with all interest thereon, is paid in  
full, and providing that in the event of default in the payment of any installment in accordance with the terms and tenor of said promissory note, said installment  
shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum, anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding;  
all of which and such other terms, conditions and agreements as herein contained, will more fully appear by reference to said note.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That said first parties, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for the better securing the payment thereof to said  
second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of  
One Dollar to first parties in hand well and truly paid by second party, and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
have granted, bargained, sold and released unto second party, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following  
described lands, to wit:

~~the tract of land described as containing forty-four and  
one-half (44 1/2) acres, more or less, known as the Isaac Worcester  
place, in Highland Township, of Greenville County, located  
near Ridge Road, about nine miles North of Greenville on Bear Creek  
bounded more or formerly on the North by lands of  
Luther Brown; on the East by lands of L. A. Worcester, on  
the South by lands of Thomas Babo Estate, and on the West  
by lands of J. S. Herring, more particularly described  
according to a plat prepared by W. P. Walker, Surveyor,  
November 1, 1933, copy of which is on file with the Federal  
Land Bank of Columbia, and being the same lands  
described in a mortgage from Co. Isaac Worcester to the  
Land Bank Commission dated January 18, 1934, recorded  
in Mortgage Book 247, page 163, in the office of the Clerk of  
Court for Greenville County.~~

The debt secured by this mortgage, which is recorded in  
Mortgage Book 263, at Page 231, having been paid in full,  
Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder  
of said mortgage and of the note thereby secured, pursuant  
to the Act of Congress, known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corp-  
oration Act, by and through The Federal Land Bank of Colum-  
bia, as its agent and attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of  
Congress, known as Farm Credit Act of 1935, does hereby de-  
clare said mortgage satisfied and the lien thereof forever  
discharged.
