## MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

1500.00 six months after date and \$1500.00 each and every consecutive six months thereafter, and interest from date at the rate of six per cent. payable semi-annually, and in behalf of said corporation execute and deliver to said bank a mortgage covering the lot of land situate in the city of Greenville, S. C. on East side of Hudson St. and Westfield St., and being the same lot of land conveyed to said corporation by Henryk. Townes by deed dated January 21, 1928 and recorded in Deed Book 103 at page 13, and also the lot adjoining the above described lot likewise situate on Hudson St. and being the same lot conveyed to said corporation by Clarence B. Martin by deed dated August 1. 1928 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 136 at page 319."
