MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

- 15. And the said mortgager doth, as additional security, hereby assign, set over and t transfer to the said mortgagee, all of the rents, issues and profits of the said mortgaged premises that may be unpaid or uncollected and that accrue or fall due from and after any default by mortgager hereunder, or any breach or violation of any agreement, condition, covenant or term of the note or mortgage, or after the service of a summons in any action of foreclosure to which said mortgagee may be a party, and the holder of this mortgage shall be entitled to the appointment of a receiver for such rents and profits as a matter of right, and if said premises be not rented, the receiver shall have the right to rent out the premises; all without consideration of the value of the mortgaged premises, as security for the amount due the mortgagee, or the solvency of any person or persons liable for the payment of such amount, anything herein or elsewhere to the contrary notwithstanding.
- 16. In the event said debt, or any part thereof, is established by or in any action for foreclosure of this mortgage, the mortgagee may also recover of the mortgagor, in addition to the said debt or so much thereof as shall be unpaid, a reasonable sum, not exceeding ten (10%) per cent upon the amount due, for attorney's fees, which shall be secured by this mortgage; and shall be included in any judgment of foreclosure recovered.
- 17. All rights and powers herein conferred are cumulative of all other remedies and rights allowed by law and may be pursued concurrently.
- 18. In case of error or omission in this mortgage or the note which it secures, a mortgage or note to collect the same, dated as of this date, will be promptly executed by the mortgagor.
- 19. It is further covenanted and agreed that any waiver by the mortgagee of any agreement, condition, stipulation or covenant of this instrument, or any violation thereof, shall not be construed as a waiver of the act at any subsequent time, or of any similar or other act or acts of commission of ommission at that time or at any subsequent time.
- 20. The mortgagor shall hold any enjoy the said premises until default in the payment of the installments, as provided in said note, or breach of any of the covenants of conditions of this mortgage shall be made; however, any agent or representative of the mortgagee may enter upon said premises at any time for the purpose of inspecting same, or for any other purpose desired by the mortgagee, and do such other things as nesessary to protect and preserve the security.

The mortgagor agrees that in the event the ownership of the mortgaged premises, or any part thereof, becomes vested in a person other than the mortgagor, the mortgagee, its successors and assigns, may, without notice to the mortgagor, deal with such successor or successors in interest with reference to the mortgage and the debt hereby secured, in the same manner as with the mortgagor, without in any way vitiating or discharging the mortgagor's liability hereunder or upon the deht hereby secured. No sale of the premises hereby mortgaged and no forbearance on the part of the mortgagee or its assigns, or release of any portion of the mortgaged premises and no extension of the time for the payment of the debt hereby secured given by the mortgagee or its assigns shalloperate to release, discharge, modify, change or affect the original liability of the mortgagor herein, either in whole or in part.
