TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Pierce M. Smith
Greenville, S. C.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Bank of Greenwood, Greenwood, S. C., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Twenty-five Hundred and no 100 Dollars (\$2,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of five per centum, 5% per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Bank of Greenwood or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Nineteen and 78/100 Dollars \$19.78 commencing on the first day of December, 1938, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of November, 1943.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee, and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain place, parcel or lot, of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Arlington Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of the property of Emmie Mc Gee, et al, as shown on a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, February, 1919, and having, according to said plat and a more recent survey entitled "Property of Pierce M. Smith, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1938", the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a post on the North side of Arlington Avenue, 202 feet West of the Northwest intersection of Greene Avenue and Arlington Avenue, and running thence along the North side of Arlington Avenue N. 70-50 W. 18 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-48 E. 147.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-40 E. 68 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28-25 W. 149.30 feet to a post on the North side of Arlington Avenue, the point of beginning.
