date, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 perfecent, per annum, to be computed and paid
annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as
principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately the, at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon an foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an
attorneys fee of ten per cent besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount
due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands
of an attorney for collection, or the said date, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or
be legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the
said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said J. E. Chandler and J. R. Chandler, Jr., in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. B. Martin according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us the said J. E. Chandler, and J. R. Chandler, Jr., in hand well and truly paid by the said J. B. Martin at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain, sell and release wanto the said J. B. Martin, his heirs and assistant.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in baklawn when Greenville County, South Carolina, containing six and sixteen one-hundredths 16/160) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at iron pin on line of Oaklawn School District No. 25 land at corner of W. E. Chandler's land; thence N. 35 W. 372.5 feet to stake; thence 66 k. 490 feet to stake; thence S. 5 W. 632 feet to mark in cement pavement of Highway No. 25; thence N. 41 W. 571 feet to mark in cement pavement of Highway No. 25; thence S. 49-30 W. 86.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 47-30 W. 216 feet to the beginning corner. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Promises before mentioned unto the said J. B. Martin, his Heirs and Assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrent and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said J. B. Martin, his Heirs and Assigns, from and against us and our Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Mortgagor does hereby covenant and agree to pay promptly when due all taxes and assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate, and also all judgements or other charges, liens or encumbrances that may be recovered against the same or that may become a lien thereon, and in default thereof said mortgagee shall have the same rights and options as above provided in case of insurance.

And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described premises to said mortgagee, or Heirs Executors, Administrators or Assigns and agree that any Judge of the Circuit Court of said State may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver, with authority to take possession of said premises and collect said rents and profits, applying the net proceeds thereof (after paying costs of collection) upon said debt, interest, cost or expenses; without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
