consideration of the premises and of One Dollar (\$1) to it duly paid by the Trusteed at or before the ensealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in order to secure the payment of both the principal of and interest and premium, if any, on the bonds from time to time issued hereunder, according to their tenor and effect and the performance of all the provisions hereof (including any instruments supplemental hereto and any modification made as in this Indenture provided) and of said bonds, hath granted, bargained, sold, released, conveyed assigned, transferred, mortgaged, pledged, set over and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargin, sell, release, convey, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, set over and confirm (subject, however, to Excepted, Encumbrances ad defined in Section 6 hereof) unto Irving Trust Company and Frederick G. Herbst, as Trustees, and to their successor or successors in said trust, and to said Trustees and their successors and assigns forever, all the following described properties of the Company:
