, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **LIBERTY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY**

, a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of **South Carolina**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Twenty-eight Hundred fifty and ^{no/100} Dollars (\$ 2,850.00)**, with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum (**4 1/2** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **Liberty Life Insurance Company** in **Greenville, South Carolina**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Eighteen and 04/100** Dollars (\$ **18.04**), commencing on the first day of **March**, 19 **42**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **February** 19 **62**.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the South side of McDowell Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 of Block C, on plat of Woodville Heights made by W. J. Riddle and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 14 and 15, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by W. J. Riddle, dated February 9th, 1942 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of McDowell Street, joint front corner of lots 17 and 18 of Block C, said pin being 368.1 feet in a Westerly direction from the Southwest corner of the intersection of McDowell and Alice Streets, and running thence with the line of Lot 17, S. 16-50 E. 222.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-10 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot 19 N. 16-50 W. 216.2 feet to an iron pin on the South side of McDowell Street; thence with the South side of McDowell Street, N. 67-38 E. 60.2 feet to the beginning corner.

The Mortgagor further agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within eight months from the date hereof (written statement of any officer or employee of the Federal Housing Administration dated subsequent to the eight months' time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage, being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility) the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.
