All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvement thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of Henrietta Avenue near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville. State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 72 on plat of Augusta Road Hills made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L at pages 56 and 57, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E.
