in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. H. Willimon

containing seventy three and one-fourth (73 1/4) acres, more or less, being a part of the land formally owned by Odam Cox, and known as Tract No. 3 in the survey and division of the same made by W. U. Hunt, Surveyor, on the 18th day of September, A. D. 1888 and being the same land conveyed to me by Julius H. Heyward by deed recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book BBB, at Page; 585:
