(\$ 1500.00 ) Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$150.00 on the 4th day of  
November, 1943, and a like amount semi-annually thereafter until May 4th, 1946 at which time the  
outstanding balance will be due and payable, with privilege of anticipating payment in full after  
May 4th, 1944.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately  
due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney  
for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said  
note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per

Greenville, known and designated as Lots Nos. 26 and 27, of the Harry G. Stephens property as  
shown by plat of same recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, Plat Book M, at  
Page 9, and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Paris View Drive and County road  
shown on said plat, and running thence along the west side of Paris View Drive 35-E 299.8 feet  
to iron pin at corner Lot No. 25; thence along line of Lot No. 25 S. 55 W. 200 feet to iron pin  
at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 25, 26, 27 and 28; thence along line of Lot No. 28 N. 84-30 W.
