conveyed to me by Mrs. Emma L. Kellett, by deed dated 15th day of June, 1943, recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 254, Page 134 and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin old Augusta Road near store S. 59 W. 9.63 crossing Augusta Highway to stone; thence S. 17 W. 3.43 along old line to iron pin by post oak; thence N. 74-15 E. 5.28 along and up gully line to maple, new; thence due East 3.00 along and up bally line to iron pin, new; thence N. 53-45 E. 5.00 crossing Augusta Highway again to iron pin in old Augusta Road; thence N. 37 W. 4.75 along old Augusta Road to the beginning corner, containing 4.9 acres by said survey, bounded on the north by land now, or lately, belonging to J.
