DEED OF TRUST - R. L. BRINSON AND WIFE

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into on this the 22nd day of September, 1944, by and between R. L. Brinson and his wife, Mildred S. Brinson, of the County of Guilford, State of North Carolina, (hereinafter called "Trustors"), P. C.
