This indenture made and entered into this the 31st day of October, 1944 by and butween Virginia Manufacturing Company, Fork Shoals, South Carolina, a corporation erganized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, with its principal place of business at Fork Shoals, South Carolina, and the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., witnesseth:

Whereas, Virginia Manufacturing Company is duly incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina and has by law and by virtue of its charter full power and authority to borrow money for its general corporate purposes and to make and issue its promissory note or notes, and to secure the same by mortgage covering any or all of its property, and

Whereas, at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the undersigned, Virginia Manufacturing Company, duly called and held in Greenville, South Carolina, on the 31st day of October, 1944, resolutions were unanimously adopted authorizing the officers of said Virginia Manufacturing Company to borrow the principal sum of Seventiative themsand dollars and issue therefor its note upon the terms and conditions hereinaster stabulated, and to be repaid as hereinaster provided, and in order to secure the parallel themsand to be repaid as mortgage on its property hereinaster described can allow the derma and stipulations hereinaster specified.

Now, Therefore, pursuant to solution of the Dord of Directors of the Virginia Manufacturing Company, duly called and holdes solves aid Know all Men by These Present that the Virginia Manufacturing Company sends greatings:

Whereas, Virginia Manufacturing Company is duly indebted to the State Carolina National Bank of Charleston, S. C., in the sum of Seventy-five thousand dollars, and and payable as follows: Four thousand dollars February 1, 1945 and Four thousand dollars the first as of each and every successive month thereafter until paid in full, bearing interest at the rate of four per cent. per annum, payable monthly, at the end of each and every constants month.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and the sum of One dollar to the Virginia Manufacturing Company in hand paid by the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in order to carry out the intention expressed in the premises, the Virginia Manufacturing Company hath given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, assign and convey unto the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., and its successors and assigns the following described land, to-wit:

(1) All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the west side of Reedy River, containing 73.4 acres as shown on plat of property of Virginia Manufacturing Company, prepared by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, September 23, 1937, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
