And said Myers-Pitts Hotel Company does hereby bind itself, its Successers and Assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said The Barringer Hotel Company, its Successors and Assigns, from and against Myers-Pitts Hotel Company, its Successors and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

And the said mortgagor agrees to insure and keep insured the houses and buildings on said let in a sum not less than Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00) Dellars from less or damage by fire and will keep the houses and buildings on said let insured in a sum not less than Three Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dellars from less or damage by windsterm or ternade, and will keep and insure the furnishings and equipment in said houses and buildings on said let from less by fire and ternade in a sum of not less than Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dellars in a company or companies satisfactory to the mortgagee, and assign and deliver the policies of insurance to the said mortgagee, and that in the event the mortgager shall at any time fail to do so, then the mortgagee may cause the same to be insured and reimburse itself for premium, with interest, under this mortgage; or the mortgagee at its election may on such failure declare the debt due and institute foreclesure proceedings.
