I, Leila Rhodes Bailey, of Greenville, S. C.,

WHEREAS I, the said Leila Rhodes Bailey

in and by me certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100

four and one-half (4 1/2) Dollars, with interest at the rate of 17 1/4 per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of TWENTY-SEVEN AND NO/100

(\$ 27.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, the contents whereof are referred to hereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Leila Rhodes Bailey

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to me and my heirs, assigns and assigns forever, I have granted, sold and released unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars to me, the said Leila Rhodes Bailey

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 8-AC, being known and designated as

Lots Nos. 88, 89 and 90, of a subdivision known as Paris-Piney Park as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 19, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Orlando Avenue and Lakeland Avenue (also known as Furman Hall Road), and running thence along the west side of said Lakeland Avenue, S. 28-53 W. 151.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55-30 W. 144.1 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 87; thence along the line of said Lot No. 87, N. 34-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Orlando Avenue; thence along the line of said Orlando Avenue, S. 55-30 E. 130 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Loran A. Rhodes by deed dated Oct. 7, 1943 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 257, page 142."
