WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor is justily indepted to AIKEN LOAN & SECURITY COMPANY a corpora tion organized and existing under the lewer of the state of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Six Thomagna and No 100 (\$6000.00) DOLLARS lawful mongation the United States of America, secured to be paid by certain note or obligation, bearing given date herewith, conditioned for payment of the principal offices of the sold AIKEN LOAN & SECURE COMPANY, in the City of Florence, in the State of South Carolina, of the sight of Six Thousand and No/100 - - - (\$6,000/09) DOLLARS in words and figures is follows: (the sum of Thirty-Six & 36/100 (\$36.36) Dolling on the ist day of August, 1946, and a like sum of Thirty-six & 36/100 (\$36.36) Dollars on the Ast May of each and every month the featter watil the debt is paid in full, with interest at the rate of Four percent (4%) per annum computed and payable monthly; the said monthly installment of Thirty six and 360100 (\$36.66) Dollars includes interest calculated on the monthly deque as the Malanck of said paincipal sum and so whuch of the installment as is necessary shall be grediffed to said interest and the balance on the principal test, and, together with, and in addition to the monthly payments of principal and interest hereby manquired, he will pay to the pritage of the let day of each month until the said got if fully paid onetwelfth of the annual tanks, of the property (securing) this loan and all of one annual premiums for Mazard Insurance on buildings on property securising hereof may collect a "listo charde" not to exceed four tents (4d) for each and in handling payment more than fifteen (25) days in arrears to cover the extra expense delinquent payments.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the raid Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the said note and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the said note or of any renewal or extension thereof, with interest thereon, and also for an in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns forever:

"All that piece, percel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northwestern side of Donny Brook Street (formerly Donny Brook Avenue), near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 83 on Plat of property of Colonial Company, made by Dalton & Meves in September 1925, and, according to survey of property of Frank J. Christopher, made by Pickell & Pickell on June 24, 1946, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwestern side of Donny Brook Street, 192 feet Southwest from Grove Street at corner of Lot No. 84, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 42-00 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46+50 W. 64 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 82; thence with the line of said Lot, S. 42-00 E. 200 feet to a stake on Donny Brook Street; thence with the Northwestern side of said Street, N. 46-50 E. 64 feet to the beginning corner."
