WHEREAS, I, Jack R. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Oak Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as the greater protion of Lot #11 of Section "A", on Plat of Woodville Heights made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, December, 1940, recorded in the R.M.C.Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "L", Pages 14 and 15 and Plat Book "K", Page 272, and having according to said Plats, a a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, September 26, 1946, the following metes and bounds to-wit:-
