All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in School District 7-H, and being at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Sycamore Drive and Boland Drive, near the City of Greenville, and designated as Lots Nos.55 and 56 on a Plat of East Lynne, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, June 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at Page 195, and having, according to said Plat, the following courses and distances, to-wit:
