"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 113 as shown on plat of Glenn Grove Park prepared by R. E. Dalten in May, 1924 and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Flat Book "F" at Page 233, and being more particularly described, according to said plat, as fellows:

"REGIMNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Monticello Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 113 and 114, which point is 374 feet in a Westerly direction from the intersection of Monticello Avenue and Grace Street, and running thence with the joint lines of said lots, S. 27-18 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence W. 62-42 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 112 and 113; thence with the joint lines of said lets, W. 27-18 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Monticello Avenue; thence along the Southern side of Monticello Avenue, S. 62-42 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."
