Nineteen hundred fifty and No/100 (\$1950.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of Four (4%) per centum per annum (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress), the first payment on interest being due and payable on the
First day of November 1948, and thereafter interest being due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in Twenty (20) equal, successive, annual installments of Sixty-five and No/100 (\$65.00)
Dollars each, and a final installment of Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Beaverdam Creek, and on a surface treated road leading from Berrys Mill to the Jordan Road containing thirty-four and 50/100 (34.50) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the north by Beaverdam Creek and lands of W. A. Stokes, on the east by Stokes and Ray Sloan, on the south by Berrys Mill and the Jordan Road with Ray Sloan and lands formerly owned by Thomas G. Sloan across the road and on the west by Beaverdam Creek. Said tract of land is specifically described by courses and distances on plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated September 1, 1947 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C., Greenville County, in Plat Book O, Page 11.
