"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carelina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the South side of the White Horse Road, near the City of Greenville, containing 2 acras, more or less, and being a portion of the 12.5 acres tract of land as shown on plat of the J. S. Machen property made by G.A. Ellis, Surveyor, March 19, 1940, and being more particularly described by mates and bounds, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of the White Horse Road, corner of the Kennedy property, and running thence with the line of said property, S. 22½ W. 825 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly owned by J.
