All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, School District 6-E, being known and designated as Lot No. 127 on Map 2 of Camilla Park, recorded in Plat Book "M", Page 85, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described according to survey and plat by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, May 6, 1948 as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Frances Avenue and Beatrice Street; thence with Beatrice Street, S. 21-55 E. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 128, S. 67-48 W. 217.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 126, N. 11-02 W. 81.4 feet to an iron pin on Frances Avenue; thence with the South side of said "venue, N. 67-48 E. 202.3 feet to the beginning.
