SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Albert Fowler

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 - - - (\$ 2,500.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 - - - - - - (\$ 25.00 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 8-FE, on the south side of Gentry street, and being known and designated as the major portion of Lot No. 26 of the property of C. E. Briscoe, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 166, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of gentry street at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to B. B. Smith, which point is 300 feet east from the southeast corner of the intersection of Gentry street and Pendleton Road, and running thence along the south side of Gentry street, N. 34-53 E. 90 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 55-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of said Lots Nos. 25 and 26; thence across the rear portion of Lot No. 26, S. 34-53 W. 86 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 26 and also the line of the property of B. B. Smith; thence along the line of the Smith property, N. 57-01 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Roy Lee Osteen and Helen E. Osteen by deed dated June 14, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 294, page 150."
