AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF MORTGAGE

THIS AGREEMENT made the 20th day of July, 1948 between Liberty Life Insurance Company, Party of the First Part, and J. E. Taylor and Buth A. Taylor, Panty of the Second Part,

WITHESSETH:

WHEREAS, to secure the said note the said party of the Second Part executed to the said Party of the First Part a certain mortgage dated the 22nd day of April, 1947, and recorded on the 22nd day of April, 1947 in Mortgage Book 362 at Page 29, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.; and

WHEREAS the said Party of the First Part is still the holder of said note and mortgage, and the said Party of the Second Part is still the owner of the said mortgaged premises, and has requested the Party of the First Part to extend the unpaid principal balance
