"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Austin Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 2 and 3 on plat of Augusta Road Extension made by W. L. Mitchell, R. S., February 16, 1925, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 285 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, tp-wit:
