Dollars, with interest at the rate of three (3%) per cent per annum, and constituting a lien upon the church property located at the corner of Brooks Avenue and Cooper Street in the Union Bleachery Village near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being the same property heretofore conveyed to J. T. Duncan, et al, as the Board of Deacons of Union Bleachery Baptist Church, by Union Bleachery, a South Carolina corporation, by its deed dated June 4, 1945, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 276, at Page 219.

The said The Aspinook Corporation, The Lawrence Print Works, Inc., and Arnold Print Works, Inc., also hereby waive and subordinate their right of reverter as contained in said deed to the lien of said mortgage to The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee for the John W. Arrington Foundation.

It is understood and agreed, however, that upon the payment of said debt and satisfaction of said mortgage, all rights of reverter contained in the deed referred to shall be restored and this subordination and waiver shall thereupon cease and become null and void and of no effect.
