Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of West Faris Road, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 106 on plat of Augusta Circle, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, November 1921, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 23, and having, according to said plat and a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, October 2, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast side of West Paris Road, at joint front corner of Lots 105 and 106, the said pin being 199.88 feet in a southwesterly direction from the point where the southeast side of West Paris Road intersects with the southwest side of Winyah Street and running thence along the line of Lot 105 S. 71-35 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot 77, S. 21-35 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 107, N. 71-35 W. 139.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of west Paris Road; thence along the southeast side of West Paris Road N. 32-27 E. 51.55 feet to the beginning corner.
