Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina: in Greenville Township, being known and designated as lot No. 42, as shown on a Plat of McCullough Heights, recorded in Plat Book E, at Page 95, and being more particularly described according to a more recent survey prepared by J. C. Hill, November 10, 1949, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Donnybrook Avenue, joint front corner of lots Nos. 42 and 43, which pin is 61.6 feet Northeast of the intersection of Donnybrook Avenue and Verdun Avenue, and running thence with Donnybrook Avenue, N. 46-25 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of lots Nos. 41 and 42; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 44-20 E. 169 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 45-26 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 42 and 43; thence with joint line of said lots, N. 44-20 W. 170 feet to the point of beginning.
