"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, .and.in. Bates. Township, on the east side of Mellon Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 25 and 26, of Block H, as shown on plat of the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine Co., Engrs., July 10, 1940 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Fat pages 63, 64 and 65, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
