FIRST.

O—The Lumberton Steam Electric Generating Station, to which the second unit is now being added, situated on the Lumber River in Wisharts and Lumberton Townships, Robeson County, near the Town of Lumberton, North Carolina, including the power houses, buildings, structures, generators, boilers, machinery, equipment, appliances, supplies, franchises, licenses, permits and consents with respect thereto, and all of the Company's lands, water rights, rights of way and easements; including, but not limited to, property recently acquired for and in connection with said generating station by and under the following condemnation proceedings, which are referred to for a more particular description of lands and rights, to-wit:

(1) Judgment in condemnation proceedings, entered in the Superior Court of Robeson County, North Carolina, as of May Civil Term, 1949, in the case of Carolina Power & Light Company vs. Joe Thorndyke and wife, Vivien Thorndyke, et al., which judgment is recorded in the office of Register of Deeds of Robeson County, North Carolina, in Book 10-R, Page 577, et seq.

P—The Goldsboro Steam Electric Generating Station now under construction, situated on the Neuse River in Brogden Township, Wayne County, approximately five miles west of Goldsboro, North Carolina, including the power houses, buildings, structures, generators, boilers, machinery, equipment, appliances, supplies, franchises, licenses, permits and consents with respect thereto, and all of the Company's lands, water rights, rights of way and easements; including, but not limited to, all such property acquired for or in connection with said generating station by and under the following deeds and condemnation proceedings which are referred to for a more particular description of said lands and rights, to-wit:

- (1) Deed dated July 8, 1949, from Gurney J. Hollowell and wife, Rena Hollowell, to Carolina Power & Light Company, which deed is recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Wayne County, North Carolina, in Book 344, Page 111, et seq.
