Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of the land conveyed to É. L. Cox by deed from Daisy B. Cleveland, adjoining the lands of E. L. Cox and Henry Cox, and having the following metes

and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corner with Henry Cox land on road, and running thence with the line of the Henry Cox land, 135 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with land of E. L.
