stone; thence South 10 degrees 40 minutes East 15.18 chains to a stone; thence South 74g degrees East 2 chains to a stone; thence South 55g degrees East 25.29 chains to a stone; thence South 55g degrees West 13.65 chains to a stone; thence South 58 degrees 40 minutes West 17.63 chains to the point of beginning. Being bounded on the North by lands of the estate of Lou Latimer, on the Northwest by lands of John Donaldson, on the Northwest, West and Southwest by a highway, on the Southeast by lands of the estate of J. C. Milford and the estate of Henry, on the East by lands of Shumate and on the Northeast by lands of Traynham;

subject, however, to that certain deed to right-of-way executed and delivered by E. D. Beeks to the South Carolina Highway Department, dated September 3, 1948, the lands covered by the deed having been heretofore released from the liens of the two mortgages aforesaid.

Only the above-described property is released from the liens of the aforesaid instruments. This release shall not affect or modify the obligations secured by the said lien instruments, and the said obligations shall continue in force and effect until fully paid, satisfied, and discharged.
