Douglas Wilson & Co., in Greenville, South Carolina . , or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Thirty-Nine and 59/100 - - - - - - Dollars (\$ 39.59 - -), commencing on the first day of March , 1950, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of February , 1975.

Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina;

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northwestern side of Meridian Avenue, in a subdivision known as Super Highway Home Sites, being known and designated as Lot No. 172 of said subdivision, and being described according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P" at Page 53, and according to a more recent plat prepared by Sam M. Hunter, Registered Engineer, dated November 15, 1949, entitled "Property of John H. L. McDonald, Near Greenville, S. C.", and having, according to said plats, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
