"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the Southern side of Russell Avenue, and being known and designated as lot No. T-15 as shown on plat of the property of C. H. Talley, recorded in the Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at Page 116, and being more particularly described, according to said plat, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Russell Avenue, joint front corner of lots Nos. T-14 and T-15, which point is 250 feet East on intersection of Russell Avenue and Bennett Street, and running thence S. 19-21 W. 114 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-30 E. 48.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19-21 E. 114 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Russell Avenue; thence with Russell Avenue, N. 70-30 W. 48.1 feet to the beginning corner."
