NOW KNOW ALL MEN, Thatwe, the saidGeorge T. Lunsford and Leila W.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms
of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tous., the said,
George T. Lunsford and Leila W. Lunsford in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described prop- erty to wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ...Greenville...... Township, on the northeast side of the Paris Mountain Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision known as "Leawood" as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs., in June, 1938, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at pages 18 and 19, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Paris Mountain Road at the corner of Lot No. 2, and running thence along the line of that lot, S. 41-13 E. 191.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot in the line of Lot No. 43; thence along the line of that lot, S. 42-15 W. 78.5 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Edgewood avenue; thence along the line of said avenue, N. 50-35 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said avenue, N. 41-46 W. 74.6 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of the intersection of Edgewood avenue with Paris Mountain Road, N. 12-41 W. 35.5 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Paris Mountain Road; thence along the line of said Paris Mountain Road, N. 52-00 E. 78 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to us by Frances W. Burns by deed dated July 26, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 354 at page 337.
