"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of .. Greenville . and .in. Greenville . Township, School District 8-A, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 of the property of Honour Coal Company as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton and Neves in April, 1940 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book U, at page 31, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of the old location of Pendleton road at its point of intersection with the P. & N. Railroad right-of-way, and running thence along the line of the P. & N. right-of-way, S. 27-20 W. 114.5 feet to an iron pin at the point of the intersection of the right-of-way of the P. & N. Railroad and the Southern Railroad; thence along the right-of-way of the Southern Railroad, N. 88-30 E. 123.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of Lot No. 3, N. 27-20 E. 71.8 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of the old location of Pendleton Road; thence along the southwest side of the old Pendleton Road, N. 71-25 W. 109.3 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
