All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Furman Hall Road and being a portion of tract #4 of the property of J. C. Hall as shown on plat thereof by R. E. Dalton dated December, 1916 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Furman Hall Road, which iron pin is 314 feet from the intersection of Furman Hall Road and Chick Springs Road, and running thence along the line of Furman Hall Road, S. 28-15 W. 125 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a lot now or formerly owned by E.
