NOW KNOW ALL MEN, ThatI, the saidFrank Hall
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms
of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tome, the said
in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Gantt. Township on the West side of White Horse Road and being known and designated as Tract No. 3 on plat of the property of J. G. Phillips made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, November, 193 and recorded in Plat Book J, at page 43, and being more particularly described as follows:
"BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corner of tracts Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence S. 59 1/2 W. 569 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of tracts Nos. 3 and 4; thence S. 22 1/4 W. 192 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of tracts Nos. 2 and 3; thence N. 59 1/2 E. 720 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of tracts Nos. 2 and 3; thence N. 30 1/2 W. 117.6 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1-3/4 acres, more or less including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J. Milton King by his deed dated August 15, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 416, at page 291."
