E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "F", pages 114-115, said lots having a frontage of 142.2 feet on the South side of Woodvale Avenue, with a depth of 247.7 feet on the East side, a depth of 234.9 feet on the West side, and being 141.3 feet across the rear and is located 640.2 feet West from Rock Creek Drive.

The note for which the within Mortgage was given to secure having been paid in full, this Mortgage is hereby satisfied and the lien thereon, for the sum of \$10,700.00, this 27th day of November, 1950.
