AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That William Maxwell

of the County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called

first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, first party is indebted to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, a corporation created, organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress, entitled the Federal Farm Loan Act, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of

Twelve Hundred and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 1200.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of four & one-half (4 1/2%) per centum per annum (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress), the first payment on interest being due and payable on the

first day of November, 1951, and thereafter interest being due and payable

annually; said principal sum being due and payable in Twenty equal, successive, annual installments of Sixty and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 60.00) Dollars each, and a final installment of - - - - -

(\$ - - - - -) Dollars the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the First day of November, 1952, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable - - - - - annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying about two miles from Gantt Station, Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being bounded on the north by Frank H. Earle and Nancy Davis; on the east by Nancy Davis, on the south by M. E. McWhite and on the West by Joe M. Chandler, and containing Thirty-eight and 12/100 (38.12) acres, more or less, being the same lands conveyed to William Maxwell by three deeds: One from M. D. Earle, dated December 18, 1919, and recorded in Deed Book 57, page 302; another from Mrs. M. E. McWhite, dated January 17, 1923, recorded in Deed Book 90, page 100, and the third from Joe M. Chandler, dated October 1, 1925, recorded in Deed Book 106, page 363.

The said tract of land is fully described by courses and distances and metes and bounds on plat compiled by C. D. Caughman, Engineer, on May 31, 1951, and reference is hereby made to that plat which is recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 198. R. M. C. Office, Greenville County.

Notwithstanding any provision herein, or in the note secured hereby to the contrary, first party may make at any time advance payments of principal in any amount. Advance principal payments made within five years from the date hereof may be applied, at the option of second party, in the same manner as those made after five years from the date hereof.
