WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY, FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of ~~Two Thousand and One Hundred~~ ~~Three~~ DOLLARS (\$3,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of ~~Five~~ ~~Four~~ per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the northeast corner of original lot No. 121, in Block 122, of South Lynn Addition, duly platted January, May, 1933, recording instrument No. 218, at page 231, and described as follows:

"Beginning at an angle in the rear corner of Johnnie Street, corner of lots 121 and 122, and running thence with the line of Johnnie Street, 121 feet, 50 feet to the right, thence with line of lot 122, S. 41° 10' E., 20 feet to the left, thence with line of lot 122, S. 41° 10' E., 20 feet to the right, thence with line of Johnnie Street, thence with the northwesterly line of Johnnie Street, N. 45° 50' E., 50 feet to the beginning corner."
