NOW, KNOW ALL MEN: That I, the said Fernella Cline, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

containing fifty acres, more or less, and having notes and bonds as shown on plat of property of D.L. Cline and Fernella Cline made by Finkell and Pickell, Surveyors, dated April 1, 1917, recorded in R.W.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 11, page 27, reference to which plat is hereby made.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to the mention herein and D.L. Cline by J.P. Bentley and W.M. Taylor by deed dated January 15, 1917, recorded in Deed Book 516, Page 230; the interest of the said D.L. Cline to said property having been conveyed to the said Fernella Cline by his decedated February 7, 1917, recorded in R.W.C. Office in Book 372, Page 301.
