"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 as shown on a Plat prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, for J. H. Bruce, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book & at Page 63, and is described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Winn's Alley, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, which pin is 167.6 feet from the intersection of Winn's Alley and Pinckney Street, and running thence with the joint line of said lot, N. 34-33 W. 105 feet to an iron pin on Ellison Alley; thence with said Alley N. 58-12 E. 48 feet to the joint corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 34-36 W. 102.3 feet to an iron pin on Winn's alley; thence with Winn's Alley, S. 55-12 W. 48 feet to the point of beginning.
