It is agreed that the Mortgager shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed. The Mortgagor waives the benefit of any appraisement laws of the State of South Carolina.
