bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
The South Carolina National Bank, Trustee under agreement with Richard  
W. Arrington dated March 23, 1945,all that tract or lot of land in  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.about three miles from the City of Greenville, on the West side of the  
White Horse Road, as shown on plat of property of Ellie Stroud Johns,  
et al, made by C. C. Jones, Registered Engineer, August 30, 1951,  
recorded in Plat Book \_\_\_\_\_, Page \_\_\_\_\_, and having according to said  
plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:BEGINNING At an iron pin on the West side of the White Horse Road,  
which point is S. 0-47 E. 88 feet from the Ware property, and running
